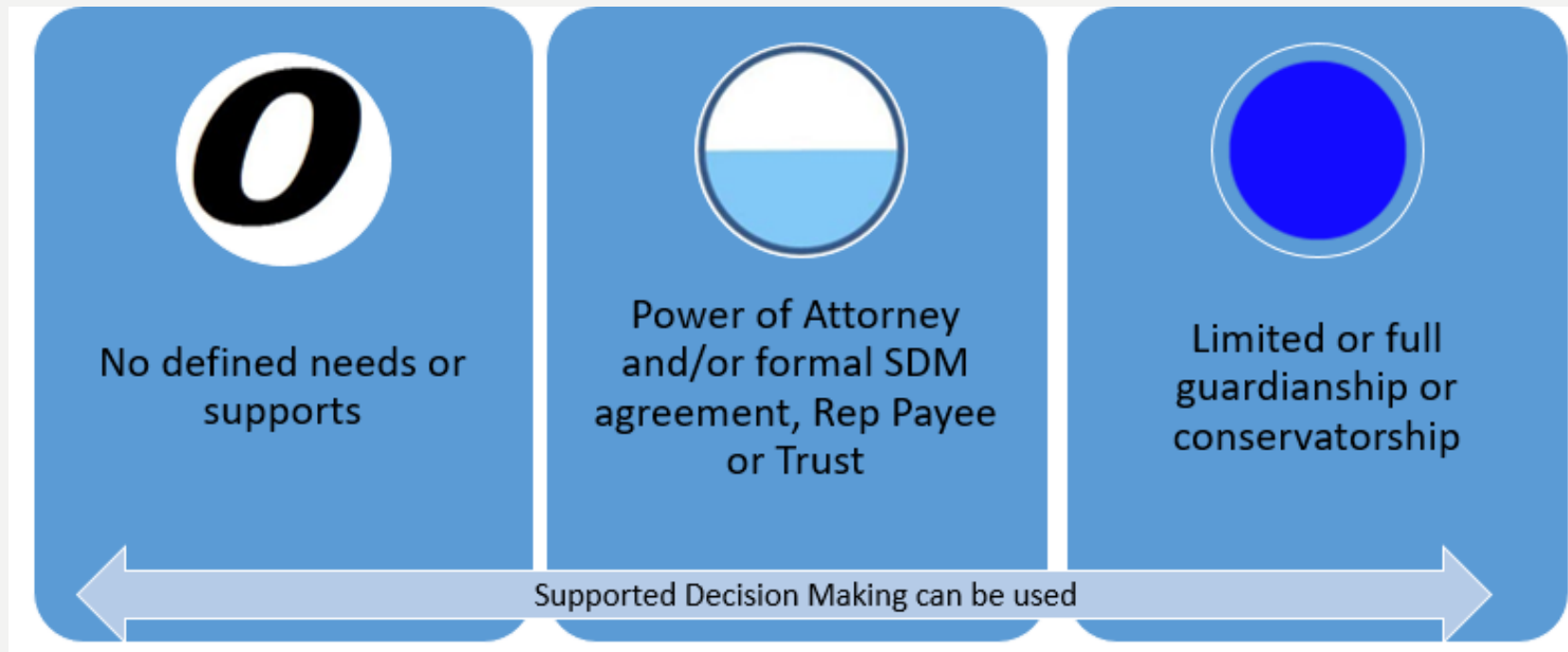

SUPPORTED DECISION MAKING IS ALWAYS AN OPTION

- SDM and guardianship should both be focused on the needs, wishes, and culture of the person with a disability
- Decisions should reflect the person, not the abstract “best”



SDM AS A PATH OUT OF GUARDIANSHIP

- SDM has been used as a way to remove guardianship
- SDM can be layered with other supports
 - POAs
 - Special Needs Trust/ABLE
 - Supportive team
