

What Is ABA Therapy?

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is an evidence-based therapy based on the science of learning and behavior.

ABA Therapy applies our understanding of how behavior works to real situations. The goal is to increase behaviors that are helpful and decrease behaviors that are harmful or affect learning.

Each child's treatment goals are personalized based on their age and individual need.

Intensive ABA Therapy can be up to 40 hours per week of direct therapy with an ABA Therapist allowing us to work on goals across all developmental domains: cognitive, adaptive, social, emotional.

1 Initial Call

2 Collect Information & Documentation

Our Intake Care Team will collect information. Prior to moving forward, we will need proper documentation to ensure a smooth and timely process.

3 ABA Assessment

Once all of the information and the insurance verification is received, we will schedule an assessment with one of our Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs).

4 Treatment Plan Review

We recommend a personalized treatment plan outlining goals and hours of services per week. Then submit it to the insurance company for authorization.

5 Start Services

When the authorization is received from insurance company, services can be scheduled.

6 Support
